## Update on Society of Aerospace Engineers' and United Nations Dangerous Goods Sub-Committee's Work on Lithium Battery Testing and Classification Projects

The Society of Aerospace Engineers (SAE) and United Nations Sub-Committee of Experts on the Transportation of Dangerous Goods are working on two lithium battery projects that will have significant, long-term implications on how lithium batteries are regulated in transport as dangerous goods. New testing requirements for lithium cells, batteries, and the packaging used for transport are being considered by SAE and the UN Sub-Committee. An overview of these projects and an update on SAE's and the UN Sub-Committee's progress will be presented.
